

Gender Pay Report 2018

Kingspan Water & Energy Limited is a subsidiary of Kingspan Group plc. The Company provides trusted market-leading solutions for rainwater harvesting and wastewater management, renewable energy technologies and hot water systems, environmental fuel storage and smart monitoring of all types of building projects.

This Gender Pay Gap Report is based on data as at 5th April 2018. At this date Kingspan Water & Energy Limited employed 775 people in the UK with 623 being male and 152 female.

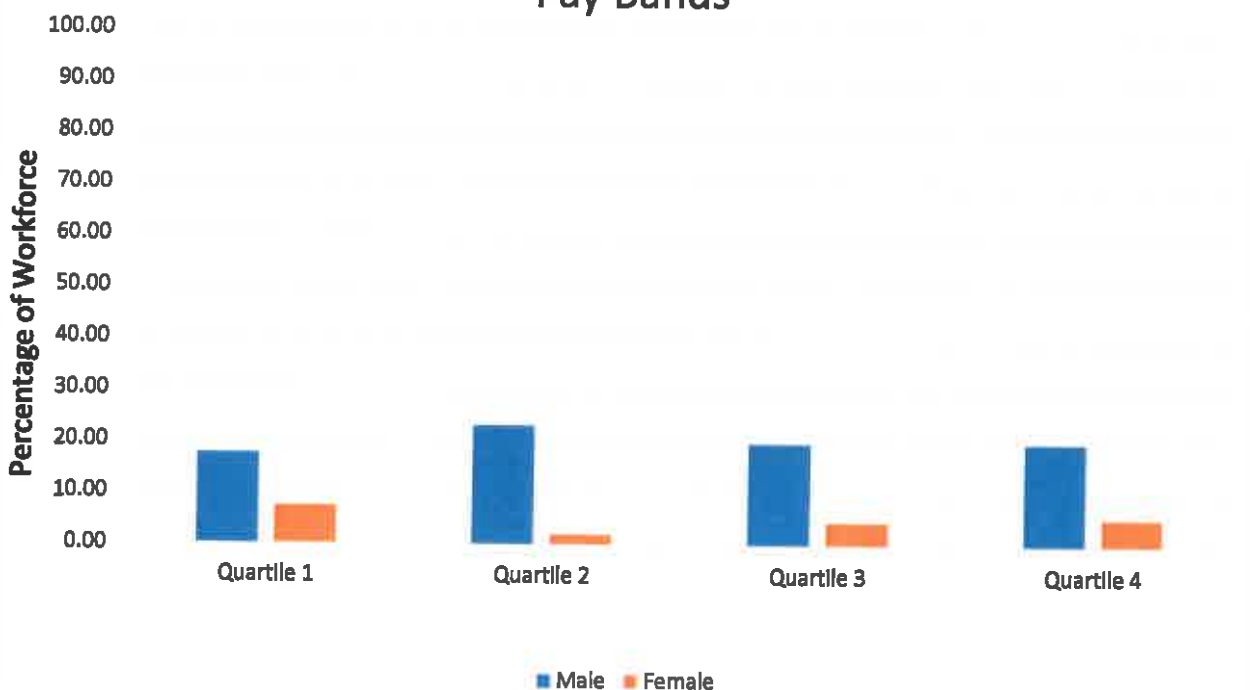
The gender pay gap measures the difference between men and women's average earnings and is shown as a percentage of men's pay. The Office of National Statistics has stated that the overall UK gender pay gap is 18.4%.

Pay and Bonus Gap

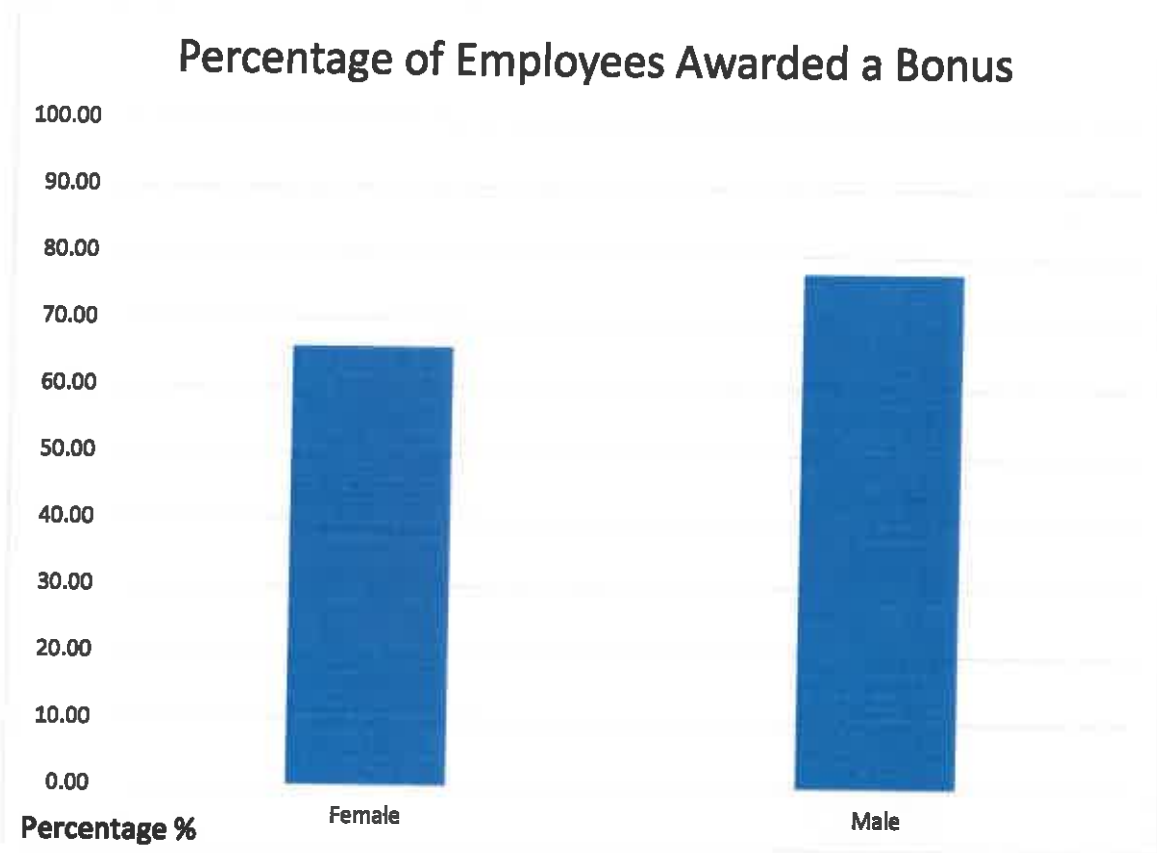

Kingspan believes that all employees should be rewarded fairly for their work and that they are provided with opportunities so that they can reach their full potential. We are confident that men and women are paid equally for doing equivalent jobs across our business.

At 4.03%, our pay gap is narrow with females receiving more average bonus payments than their male counterparts. All Kingspan employees are eligible to participate in the performance bonus scheme. The difference between male and female receiving a bonus is due to the fact that there is a 6 month waiting period before bonus is payable.

The Company continues to encourage all staff to pursue their careers within our business and for females to consider roles that were traditionally viewed as being male dominated.
