The Design

After an Earthquake deemed Christchurch police headquarters unsafe, the police force needed a new temporary base from which to operate. A key requirement for this project was for it to be a single storey building large enough to accommodate for 600 police staff, as well as an additional 35 members of staff from the Corrections Department.

This 7500sq metre police station now operates as a temporary base for police staff in the heart of the city.



Fast Construction

Christchurch Police needed to relocate to a new premise quickly in order to continue operating within the city. The original 13 Storey headquarters building was deemed unsafe to work in and a temporary solution was urgently required.

"Kingspan worked closely with Apollo Projects to construct this building within the strict time frame. The Micro-Rib and Trapezoidal roof panels incorporated into this design are assembled off site, significantly increasing the speed of construction. This service enabled the project to be completed within 6 months."



Business and Personal Protection
